ORDER OF SERVICE

DEATH EDUCATION

AKA Thanatology – education about death that focuses on the human and emotional aspects of death, primarily teaching and coping and grief.

- My definition – teaching and learning to help dignify and recognize death in a manner that affirms life and in turn, enhances relationship.

GRIEF

Deep sorrow, especially that caused by someone's death.

- My definition –our emotional & behavioural response to loss, not death

MOURNING

The expression of deep sorrow for someone who has died, typically involving following certain conventions such as wearing black clothes.

- My definition – the intentional effort and outward delivery of our grief to help express our loss.

NUCLEAR FAMILY

The traditional type of family structure. This family type consists of two parents and children.

- My definition – Bailey, Harper, Dylan & Bowen

EXTENDED FAMILY

Two or more adults who are related, either by blood or marriage.

- My definition – Mom & Dad Allen, Mom & Dad Critchley, Brothers/Sisters/Neices/Nephews.

ORDER OF SERVICE

SINGLE FAMILY

One parent raising one or more children on his own. This family may include a single mother with her children, a single dad with his kids, or a single person with their kids.

STEP FAMILY

Two separate families merging into one new unit. It consists of a new husband, wife, or spouse and their children from previous marriages or relationships.

GRANDPARENT FAMILY

Many grandparents today are raising their grandchildren for a variety of reasons. One in fourteen children is raised by his grandparents, and the parents are not present in the child's life. This could be due to parents' death, addiction, abandonment or being unfit parents.
